

French

Year 1 and 2 will be using Old Macdonald's Farm in French to learn about animal names. They will also be learning French numbers and basic greetings. They will be listening to a French version of The Three Little Pigs and taking part in French conversations using stick puppets.

RE - Christianity - Lifestyles— identifying and respecting everyone's uniqueness and valuing diversity. We will learn about the importance for Christians of love, of forgiveness and of loving both God and one's neighbours.

PSHE - New Beginnings

This theme focuses on helping children see themselves as valued individuals within a community and how they can contribute to a welcoming, safe and fair learning community for all. They will be discussing school and class rules and home school agreements.

Science -

We will be working scientifically by asking questions, observing closely, performing tests, identifying and classifying, gathering and recording data, and suggesting answers to questions.

We will be identifying and naming a range of common animals (reptiles) . We will be looking at life cycles, food chains and habitats. We will be learning about carnivores and herbivores as well as how to meet the needs of reptiles as pets.




We will also be identifying and naming a variety of common plants around our homes and school, including garden plants, wild plants and trees, and those classified as deciduous and evergreen. We will be looking at the structure of a variety of common plants including roots, stem, leaves and flowers.

Art and Design and Technology- Portraits

Children will be looking at a variety of different self-portraits by famous artists. They will use observation and drawing techniques to draw parts of the face, followed by completing their own self-portrait. They will be investigating with different types of lines, as well as mixing and using paint. They will evaluate their own work and suggest improvements.

Music - Year 1 and 2 will be learning Pirate songs and Harvest songs in preparation for performances in school.

PE and Swimming

Year 1 and 2 will be developing their swimming skills on Tuesday afternoons at the Wentworth Leisure Centre. They will also be working on developing fundamental PE skills—those basic skills that pupils need to master in order to access other areas of the PE curriculum.

Computing

We will be learning how to log on to the school internet and also onto school360 using our usernames and passwords. We will learn about personal information and how to keep it private when using the internet. We will be using JIT5 on school 360 to publish our Top Tips for keeping safe on the internet. We will be developing familiarity and correct use of keyboard – spacebar, backspace, shift (for capital letters), return etc . We will be learning how to save our work and edit it.

Geography - Maps

We will be using simple compass directions (North, South, East and West) and locational and directional language [for example, near and far; left and right], to describe the location of features and routes on a map.

We will be looking at aerial photographs and plan perspectives to recognise landmarks and basic human and physical features; we will devise a simple map; and use and construct basic symbols in a key.

We will use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of our school and its grounds and the key human and physical features of its surrounding environment.
